Spearfish Senior Center Board Meeting Minutes November 11, 2024

Present: President Ginger Childers, Vice President Taffy Tucker, Secretary Jane Rutherford, Connie Hyde, Dennis Dahl, Marla Loken, Carol Vercoe, Carol Hess, LeRoy Lanphear, Treasurer Alyce Harich, and Executive Director Stephanie Crago. The meeting was opened by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. The minutes of the last meeting were accepted as written.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented.

Visitors: Members Jane Mattson, Jim Haeder, Stan James, and Jerri Kiefer also attended the meeting.

Ways and Means: Building rental income for the month of October was \$250. November will be about \$50.

Director's Report: There was a HUGE turnout for the primary election at our Senior Center on November 5th. This is a service we provide for our community, and we do not charge for the use of our facility. There was a great turnout at Arby's on Sunday, November 10th and 15% of all proceeds between 5:00-7:00pm were donated to our Senior Center. Our Fall rummage sale in October went very well bringing in over \$12,000. The November birthday luncheon was well attended with approximately 70 people and income was \$524. October breakfast also had about 70 people and income was \$630. On October 30th, 50 people attended the Pioneer Bank Seminar on Estate and Trust Planning. The bank thanked us for the great attendance. Holiday Craft Fair and Bake Sale will be Saturday, November 16th. from 9:00-2:00pm. Annual Meeting and Turkey Dinner on November 23rd at 11:00am. We received a \$2000 Nexxus Grant through the S.D. Dept of Health for applying and being an approved "non-profit" in good standing.

Old Business:

New Business: Dennis made a motion, Taffy seconded it, to approve days off for Stephanie on November 27th, December 26th and December 27th. All in favor. Jane Mattson informed the board that additional volunteers are needed to help host and manage the monthly breakfasts. Jim Haeder presented a Volunteer Contribution overview. Dennis Dahl discussed the issue with ice and drainage problems on the roof and gutters during winter. Roger will research solutions. The Senior Center will be closed **November 28th** and **November 29th**. Also, **December 24th**, **December 25th**, **December 31st**, and **January 1st**. Although the Senior Center will be open on Thursday, December 26th and January 2nd, there will be *no caramel rolls*.

The board moved to an Executive Session.

Meeting adjourned.


